“RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATIONS”

WHEREAS, the McPherson County Board of Commissioners has provided a contingency line item in the 2010 McPherson County Annual Budget, as allowed by SDCL 7-21-6.1, and

WHEREAS, Said contingency amount may be used to cover appropriations in which insufficient amounts were provided, and

WHEREAS, McPherson County has such appropriations with insufficient amounts provided.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That appropriations be transferred from the commissioners contingency line item in the 2010 Annual Budget for McPherson County to the following budget categories, and in the following amounts:
