

**McPherson County Drainage Commission**

**Minutes of Proceeding**

**March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

The McPherson County drainage board met on Tuesday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Rick Beilke called the meeting to order at 10:30AM. Members present were: Sid Feickert, Anthony Kunz, Delmar Metzger and Jeff Neuharth. Others present were: Don Kallenberger, Austin Hoffman, and Glenn Spitzer.

A letter submitted by Jerome Mack in regards to Drainage Permit #13-11 was reviewed by the board. The States Attorney is instructed to send correspondence to Mr. Kiesz regarding Mack's letter and if Mr. Kiesz wishes dispute the drainage permit he is to submit a formal written complaint to the board.

Also in regards to Drainage Permit #13-11 the right of way where Mr. Mack placed the outlet will be surveyed at the county's expense. The State's Attorney is instructed to send correspondence to Mr. Mack requesting the outlet located in the county right of way be cased and trenched under the road to ensure that the county right of way is protected.

Discussion was held on the possibility of dissolving the drainage board as well as the future work that needs to be done at the Leola spillway.

At 11:10AM Neuharth moved and Feickert seconded to adjourn the Drainage Commission meeting and resume meeting as the McPherson County Board of Commissioners. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
