The proposed route to haul the turkey manure from Boulder Colony at 33449 121<sup>st</sup> Avenue is 2 miles north on 334<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 2 miles west on 119<sup>th</sup> Street, 10 miles north on 331<sup>st</sup> Avenue, 3 miles west on 109<sup>th</sup> Street and 3 miles north on Highway 47 to 1-127-73.
