

**McPherson County Drainage Commission**

**Minutes of Proceeding**

**December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

The McPherson County drainage board met in regular session on Tuesday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Sid Feickert called the meeting to order at 10:30AM. Members present were: Anthony Kunz, Delmar Metzger, Rick Beilke and Jeff Neuharth. Others present were: Scott Schauer, Colin Hoffman, Glenn Spitzer, Lanette Butler and Leif Redinger.

Discussion was held on permit #18D-04, a proposed small boundary ditch between the NW1/4 and the NE1/4 of 13-126N-68W, submitted by Scott Schauer on behalf of landowner Ruby Ketterling. Leif Redinger from Helms Engineering presented an elevation survey he completed at the request of Schauer. Adjacent landowners and the county highway superintendent were present and expressed concerns they had with the proposed project. Neuharth moved and Metzger seconded to deny permit #18D-04 until flow rate numbers could be examined as adjacent landowners and the Board had concerns that the project would force additional water onto the adjacent landowner's property as well as the west side of the city of Leola. Applicant would be required to provide the flow rate numbers from the engineer if he wanted the application reconsidered. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Spitzer updated the board on the maintenance completed in the county right of way the east side of the drainage issue occurring at SE1/4NE1/4 of 9-127N-67W.

At 11:00AM Metzger moved and Kunz seconded to exit drainage board and resume meeting as the McPherson County Board of Commissioners. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
