OTHER MATTERS DISCUSSED AND ACTION TAKEN:

Drainage Board

At 10:30AM Neuharth moved and Kunz seconded to forego a drainage board meeting for the month of August due to no new drainage permits submitted. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Wachter Township

Mike Klipfel and Duane Klipfel from Wachter township came before the board to discuss the road conditions of five miles of Township road due to the increased traffic from the Beef Plant semi's. Discussion was held with the board upon the possibility of the County helping to maintain that five miles. The highway superintendent also joined into the discussion. The different options for maintenance on that five miles will be looked into further by the highway superintendent and the subject will be revisited at the September meeting.

2018 Budget

The 2018 provisional budget was discussed. The Auditor will make the boards requested changes. The provisional budget hearing will be held at the September 5th meeting.

Permit to Occupy Right of Way

Beilke moved and Kunz seconded to approve the right of way application submitted by Dickey Rural Network to plow communication line in Section 2 of 128-68. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

2nd & 3rd Floor Bathroom Repairs

Metzger moved and Neuharth seconded to have all the work done that was suggested by Fischer's plumbing with the only change being to eliminate the toilet in the 3rd floor women's bathroom instead of replacing the toilet. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Air Conditioning Quotes

The quote from Les' Standard for installing 11 mini splitt indoor wall air-conditioning/heating units was received. The quote was for \$27,988.61.

Beilke moved and Metzger seconded to have Les' Standard order the 11 units and to get electrician quotes to do the electrical work. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Highway Department

Beilke moved and Kunz seconded for the chairman to sign the State of South Dakota Joint Powers Financial and Maintenance Agreement between the Department of Transportation and McPherson County. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on the Leola Dam spillway. The highway superintendent is working with the Department of Natural Resources on the potential issues with the spillway. Further discussion will take place at the September meeting.

Construction is underway on the bridge on county road 1 and the guard rail is also being repaired on county road 23 North of Wetonka. The work on both projects should be completed within the next two weeks.

A complaint on an approach entering a driveway on County road 8 was discussed.

There is an issue with crops planted in the right of ways interfering with the visibility of right of way markers. Discussion took place on the matter and the highway superintendent is to work with the landowners to resolve the issue.

The Genie man lift will be having an estimated \$5,000 worth of repairs to it. The highway superintendent will be attending a meeting with Helms & Associates regarding the proposed bike trail that the City of Leola would like to build.

Neuharth moved and Beilke seconded to transfer \$54,223.72 from unorganized to county road and bridge. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Upcoming Meetings

Neuharth moved and Beilke seconded the following meeting authorizations: Jennifer Guthmiller, Donna Breitag, Glenn Spitzer, and John Hilgemann to attend the Fall Officials Workshop and for the Veteran Service Officers to attend the annual benefit meeting in Pierre. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Miscellaneous Items and Reports

Discussion was held on the burn ban, for the time being the board is not making any changes to the ban.
