

RESOLUTION NUMBER 12-12

“RESOLUTION BANNING OPEN BURNING WITHOUT PRIOR AUTHORIZATION”

WHEREAS, McPherson County is experiencing extremely dry conditions and

WHEREAS, McPherson County desires to protect the health and safety of all residents and property within the county boundary and

WHEREAS, an emergency situation exists:

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED: That the McPherson County Board of Commissioners enacts this resolution on an emergency basis and does hereby impose a ban on all open burning within the county boundaries that has not been approved and authorized by the Chief of the Fire District where the real property is located. The granting of authorization and preapproval to conduct such an open burn will not remove or release the party seeking such authorization from any and all liability that may be associated with damages that may occur as a result of such burn. This ban shall remain intact until such time as conditions improve and a subsequent resolution by the McPherson County Board of Commissioners is enacted removing said ban.
