Manure haul permit 21-M-02 is to haul manure from Boulder Colony to parts of 11, 12, 13 & 14 -128-71. Motion to approve 21-M-01 and 21-M-02 with the date of application extended to November 1, 2021 and that the McPherson County highway superintendent be contacted prior to any hauling taking place to ensure that the route is still in acceptable condition for truck transportation of the manure was made 1st by George Hulscher and 2nd by Alvin Kallas. Motion passed.

Motion to move out of the zoning board of adjustment was made 1st by Richard Kolb and 2nd by Dan Mettler. Motion passed.

Motion to approve the July 15, 2021 zoning board minutes as published was made 1st by Richard Kolb and 2nd by Alvin Kallas. Motion passed.

The board continued with updating the zoning ordinance. Wind energy setbacks were discussed at length. Discussion also included decommissioning and energy storage facilities for wind and solar energy. Additional discussion took place on electrical interference associated with wind energy.
