

**McPherson County Board of Commissioners**  
**Minutes of Proceedings**  
**December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

The McPherson County Board of Commissioners met telephonically in special session on Thursday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The call could be heard in the Commissioners chambers. Chairman Rick Beilke called the meeting to order at 9AM. Members' present were Mark Opp, Anthony Kunz, Sid Feickert, and Jeff Neuharth.

Feickert moved and Opp seconded to approve the agenda of the December 5th Special Meeting. Upon roll call all voted in favor. Motion carried. No conflicts of interest were declared.

Moratorium

Neuharth moved Opp seconded to enact a moratorium on any Data Center conditional use permits until an ordinance can be adopted. Upon roll call all voted in favor. Motion carried.
