## McPherson County Drainage Commission Minutes of Proceeding September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The McPherson County drainage board met on Tuesday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Chairman Sid Feickert called the meeting to order at 10:00AM. Members present were: Mike Mardian, Neal Woehlhaff, Mark Opp and Jeff Neuharth. Discussion was held on what recourse an adjacent landowner would have if their neighbor installs drain tile that causes damage to their land.

Mardian moved and Opp seconded to enter executive session at 10:05AM to discuss legal matters SDCL 1-25-2(3). All voted in favor. Motion carried. Neuharth moved and Mardian seconded to exit executive session at 10:15AM. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Highway superintendent Glenn Spitzer asked the commission to consider allowing the department to finish the rock crossing on a section line in the SE1/4 of Section 23 of T127N-R67W. Discussion was held on the project and the area.

Opp moved Mardian seconded to have the county hwy department finish the rock crossing on the section line in the SE1/4 of Section 23 of T127N-R67W by adding top dress material and cleaning the county right of way in the area; the road wash to the east of the rock crossing will also be addressed. All voted in favor. Motion carried. After the county completes the work, the landowners can apply for a drainage permit if they have further drainage concerns in the area.

At 10:25AM Neuharth moved, and Woehlhaff seconded to adjourn the Drainage Commission meeting and resume meeting as the McPherson County Board of Commissioners. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
